## What to Bring

Kit, bibs, match balls – ‘home team’ to provide balls for matches

Water bottles (if it’s hot like last year, hydration will be very important)

## Refreshments

Hot and cold food and drink will be available across the day – head towards the HQ/Clubhouse

## Toilets

There are plenty of portaloos and proper toilets/washbasins near to and in the Clubhouse

## First Aid

Paramedics from CTC are stationed near the Clubhouse – they can be radioed from pitch side for more urgent care

## Parking

Please follow guidance for your age groups above

We operate a one-way system in the car park fields – **exit is not the entrance** – please follow signs and stewards in hi-vis (the orange arrows below designate the exit route)



Please consider others and try not to drive or park like you stole it when on the site

There is no access to the site via the ‘usual’ entrance – this is for emergency services access only so please don’t try.

## Tournament Rules and Regs

Respect fistbumps or whatever before the start of every game

Team – 5 a side

Squad size – 10 max

Duration – minimum 8 minute matches (no half times) – please check the Tournify app on the day for schedules and timings

**Be on time for ko** – more than 3 minutes late = 5-0 win granted to the opposing team

'Away' team wear bibs if kits clash

'Home' team choose ends. 'Away' team get the kick-off

Balls – use season 25/26 sizes for your age group – 'home team' provides balls for matches

Subs – rolling

Pass ins, not throw ins

Points – Win = 3, Draw = 1

Overhead is allowed except for keepers (to avoid endless whistles) – corner awarded for overhead – keepers can kick or throw, just not overhead

Only keepers allowed in the area – free kick awarded for entry at point of entry

Keepers cannot leave the box but can pick the ball up from back-passes

Multiple, time wasting back-passes can result in free kicks being awarded

2 step penalties or retaken (one retake only) – taken from the edge of area

Free kicks – as per normal rules unless close to penalty area – wall at edge of area

Referee can award free kicks, sin bins and automatic penalties for serious foul play or abuse from anywhere on the pitch – their decisions are final

Respect fistbumps or whatever at the end of every game

The CFA have advised that as this is a CFA sanctioned tournament, participants are subject to the disciplinary processes of the CFA
