Kit & Membership — Season Briefing 2026/27
For Parents Communication

FOR PARENTS

Redruth United - New Season Information for Parents/Guardians

We've simplified how kit and club membership works this season — and we think you'll like the change. You're now in control of ordering exactly what your child needs, when they need it, at a straightforward price.

01 You'll soon be sent a link by your coach to register your child/children with the club and the FA.

Before you begin you'll need a copy of their ID (passport ideally), and to upload a recent photo. The normal registration deadline is 28 July.

02 Full membership is £120 for the season, to be paid as £10 a month via GoCardless — our recommended option, starting in July. No lump sum, no waiting, and no need to cancel and re-set-up between seasons.

03 Associate membership is £60 for the season, to be paid as £5 a month via GoCardless — our recommended option, starting in July, on the same continuous basis. Associate members train with the club but are not eligible for match selection. The minimum kit requirement for associates is a training top. Match kit can be added if they later move to full membership.

04 If you have an existing standing order for your child's membership, please cancel it once you've set up the new GoCardless payment. If there's any overlap between the two, the club will refund the difference.

05 You order your child's kit directly through our Pendle portal. We'll share the link via Spond in early July. You choose what your child needs, pay Pendle directly, and it arrives within around a week.

06 Kit prices are the same for every family in every team. Some teams have shirt sponsors — that doesn't affect what you pay. The club handles that side of things so every family sees the same price.

07 Kit needed for the new season: a match shirt, shorts, socks, and a training top. Both the match shirt and training top carry your child's squad number — your coach will confirm this before the portal opens. Training tops carry the club badge only, with no sponsor print.

08 Shirt, shorts and socks from last season are fine to reuse if they still fit, and your squad number or sponsor haven't changed. Kit design is staying consistent so there's no need to replace items that are still good.

09 There's a delivery charge per order (around £4). If you coordinate with other parents in your child's team and order at the same time, you can split the delivery cost between you.

10 You'll need to be on Spond to access the kit portal link. If you haven't joined yet, ask your coach to add you — they'll be able to get you set up directly. Everything kit-related will be shared through Spond, not group chats.

11 Optional extras like hoodies or rain jackets are available but are not required kit. We'll share details for those who are interested, but there's no obligation.
